SECTION I Student Information

- ❖ Print clearly or type all information requested
- ❖ You must reside in British Columbia or the Yukon and be a Canadian Citizen
- ❖ Bursaries are awarded to students attending on a full time basis for **two consecutive semesters**
- ❖ Bursaries are given for need. If gross household income exceeds \$40,000 special circumstances must be involved. Without extenuating circumstances applicants whose household income is beyond \$40,000 should not apply.
- ❖ Student **MUST** apply only to the Legion that he or she lives closest to.

SECTION II College/University Information

- ❖ Please fill out the information to which school you will be attending. If applying to more than one college/university please attach a separate sheet. Please let interviewer know which one you have been accepted.

SECTION III Financial Information

- ❖ Please print the appropriate information. Applicant should bring in previous years T-4 slips as proof of income. (Students living at home need to bring in proof of parent/parents income as well).

SECTION IV Military Service Information (For Bursary From Poppy Account Only)

- ❖ Applicant must be a veteran, ex-service personnel or their child, grandchild or great grandchild if applying for a bursary from the Poppy Fund. Applicant must bring proof of military service to the interview, i.e. a photocopy of discharge papers or service record.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ❖ Must be attending post-secondary institution in British Columbia for a bursary from the Meat Draw Account.
- ❖ Applicant must come to the interview with a letter advising of their aims and objectives.
- ❖ Applicant must comply with the above and arrange for an interview before the May 31st deadline in order to be eligible. Please contact Gail Green at (604)531-2422.
